

JOE ALLEN BLAKE: 1941-2008

PENDLETON, ORE. — Joe Allen Blake, 67, formerly of Amarillo, Texas, died Monday, Aug. 11, 2008.

Graveside services will be at 9 a.m. Friday in Llano Cemetery in Amarillo with the Rev. Kevin Burris, minister of Golden Spread Cowboy Church, officiating. Local arrangements are by Brooks Funeral Directors.

Joe Allen Blake was born June 7, 1941, in Amarillo to Erfal and Jaunita Blake. He was raised in Texas, where he graduated from Amarillo High School in 1959. He also attended West Texas State University for two years. He moved to La Grande from Amarillo in 1992, and to Pendleton in 2000. He was a cattle rancher for many years, and he enjoyed roping and team roping.

He was preceded in death by his parents and a grandson, Joel Torres.

Survivors include a son, David Blake of Boise, Idaho; a daughter, Anita Padilla of Taos, N.M.; two brothers, Ron Blake and Bill Blake, both of Amarillo; four grandchildren; and two great-grandchildren.
