Clifford Hale Dines, 63, died Thursday, Nov. 6, 2003.

Mr. Dines was born in Amarillo and raised in Loveland, Colo. He was in the first graduating class of Tascosa High School.

He served in the Navy and was a graduate of West Texas State University. He married Nancy Newburg in 1962 in Bainbridge, Md. He was a comptroller for Gulf Steel in Houston until his retirement in 1988 at which time he returned to Amarillo.

In Amarillo, he worked as a real estate agent for Scott & Co. as well as Real Estate Concepts. He spent most of his time doing what he loved the most, farming and raising horses.

He was preceded in death by his father, Fred T. Dines in 1994; and his stepfather, Rex Skow in 2001.
