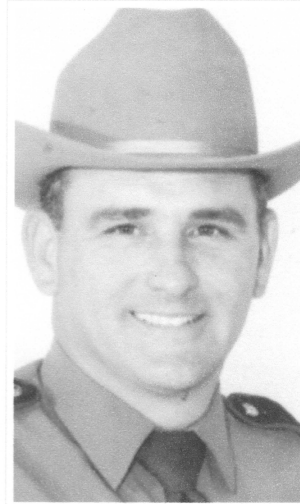
Geiser died Tuesday, Dec. 20, 2011, in Bridgeport.
