Services for Janet Burford, wife of Highland Park Mayor Sam Burford, Jr., were held Saturday, January 16, at 11 a.m., at Highland Park Presbyterian Church with Dr. Clayton Bell and Dr. Jim Smith officiating.

Mrs. Burford died Thursday morning at Baylor Hospital following a brief illness. She was 46.

She was born in Dallas and moved to Amarillo at a young age. She graduated from Amarillo High School and the University of Texas.

She was a sustaining member of the Dallas Junior League and a former

member of the board, a member of Crystal Charity Ball, Dallas Woman's Club, past president of the Highland Park High School P.T.A., past president of Children's Medical Center Auxiliary, and Ladies Chairman of the Byron Nelson Golf Tournament.

At the time of her death, she was serving as Province President of Kappa Kappa Gamma and a member of the Highland Park Presbyterian Church, where she had served as a Bible study leader.

Mrs. Burford was preceded in death by a brother, Dan Jones, and her father, Dr. E.K. Jones. She is survived by her husband and three daughters, Melissa, Ashley and Blaire Burford,

and her mother, Mrs. E.K. Jones of Amarillo.
