COLLINSVILLE – Aubrey Lee Lewis, 72, a resident of Collinsville, Texas, died on Aug. 1, 2013, at his home.

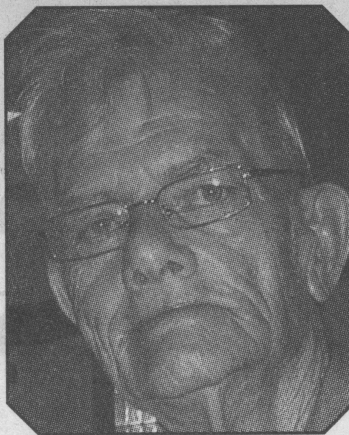
