

Peggy Powers Wiley:1940-2002 Amarillo

Peggy Powers Wiley, 62, of Amarillo died Monday, Nov. 11, 2002.

Services will be at 2 p.m. Saturday in Blackburn-Shaw Funeral Directors Memorial Chapel, Fifth Avenue and Pierce Street, with the Rev. Bill Fitzgerald of San Jacinto United Methodist Church. Burial will be in Memorial Park Cemetery.

Mrs. Wiley was descended from some of the earliest Panhandle settlers who arrived in Texas around 1872. She was born Sept. 23, 1940, to S.F. Powers Jr. and Laverne Green Powers of Amarillo. She married Herman Wiley on Dec. 28, 1958.

She was a loving wife, mother and grandmother. She was an insurance agent for Farmers Insurance Group for six years and a bookkeeper for 10 years. She had a lifelong passion for genealogy.
